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# Changing Working Patterns Career Breaks

Type of Guidance Fact Sheet (CWP 4)

#### Overview

This fact sheet is part of a set of fact sheets that provide you with a guide to changes in working patterns together with information about how these changes could impact on your pension. The impact on your pension may vary depending on what scheme you are in.

**Note:** Any change in working patterns or breaks in service need to be agreed with your employer.

This fact sheet provides information with regard to understanding how career breaks affect any reckonable service and contributions.

### Classic, Classic Plus and premium

If you take a career break you will not build up any reckonable service during your absence and you will not have to pay contributions. You will therefore not build up any pension for the duration of your career break. If you return you will return to whichever scheme you were a member of when you left. Depending on how long your career break is, you may wish to look at ways of boosting your pension to make up for the missed pension benefits.

#### **Nuvos**

If you are not paid, you will not build up any pension.

Can I pay contributions while I'm on a career break? No.

I have a partnership pension account – can money be paid into my investment fund while I'm on a career break?

Your employer will not make any contributions to your fund while you are on a career break. As it is your investment fund, you can decide if you wish to make voluntary payments to increase the value of your fund while you are on your career break.
